
















## EAPC


- Founded 1988










# Summary: International resources linking palliative care people

International collaboration and networking: How to get started



## Step 1 – dipping a toe

- Research a country or service that interests you (website, annual report)
- Develop a personal link (conference, author)
- Email exchange between staff
- Look at journals and alert colleagues to grants etc

## Step 2 – up to your knees

- Invite international guest speaker to staff meeting. Invite supporters and local press.
- Hold a World Hospice and Palliative Care Day event to support international pall. care
- Offer a clinical placement. Encourage your coworkers to support it.
- Plan a fundraising event to pay for a journal subscription
- Organise a collection of medical consumables

## Step 3 – wading in

- Volunteer your skills and help with teaching or service development
- Develop a partnership with another team or hospice (twinning)
- Develop a joint academic or research project
